Target groups:

Assessors, trainers, ECC Standard Committee and representatives of EFESC National Agencies

Aim:

Fine-tuning of the way of assessment (theory and practice), assessment scheme, Critical Points. Facing and moving all in the same direction.

Objectives:

- Information of EFESC Assessor codes of Practice
- Assessment of knowledge (differences and similarities amongst the ECC certified Assessment Centres)
- Practical skills testing (role of assessor – behaviour, use of scoresheet)
- Assessment methodology (differences and similarities)
- Implement a real ECC exam

Exam ECC1, 2 or 3

As assessors we all have experience in training and assessing candidates in working with chainsaws. However, as certified ECC assessor, it is always wise to perform yourself an exam. Just for proofing to the candidates that you have gained all the required levels and on the other hand to feel what the participants are feeling (a little exam stress and the performance of the assessors).

For this reason, the workshop is also open for those who want to perform a real ECC exam.

If you have already an ECC 1 and 2 certificate than you can do on the second day an ECC3 exam. If not you have to start from step 1.

So please, put all your pride, self-esteem or uncertainty aside and sign in to perform an official ECC exam.

09.00 -10.00 exam matrix, exam document in relation to theory and practise exam

10.00 – 12.00 practice ECC1 exam.

13.00 – 15.30 Practice ECC2 exam in forest

15.30 – 16.30 Conclusion and recommendations

Tuesday 21 November

08.30 hours pick up at train station

09.00 arrival IPC

09.00 – 11.00 demonstration Pilot entry test for ECC3 (for those participants with a lot of experience)

12.00 – 13.00 Lunch in Forest

13.00 – 15.30 practice ECC3 in forest.

Assessment by using an application on a tablet (experience of Inverde)

15.30 – 16.30 Conclusion and recommendations

Note: There is the possibility to integrate a real ECC exam for those who are interested and willing to perform it. We therefore ask from each National Agency to bring along their theory questions of each level in their own language (25 multiple choice questions of each level)

IPC will arrange the chainsaws, material, wood and a suitable foreststand.

For personal protective equipment we propose that each participant brings along its own. In case of emergency we are able to provide.
